At Kutch Copper Limited, we recognize our responsibility to manage waste in a manner that prioritizes environmental sustainability, health and safety. It aims to align national and international environmental laws and regulations related to waste management, transboundary movement of hazardous waste and the principles of the circular economy, promoting the efficient use of resources, reducing waste generation and maximizing the value of waste materials by adopting 6R principle.

This policy applies to all employees, and business partners engaged in Kutch Copper Limited (KCL).

Kutch Copper shall strive to:

- Ensure compliance with all applicable environmental laws and regulations.
- The 6R (refuse, reduce, reuse, recycle, recover and responsible disposal) principles to effectively manage waste.
- Ensure that the business meets its obligations under Extended Producer Responsibility (EPR) for plastic waste, and e-waste management regulations,
- Provide training to relevant stakeholders to raise awareness about best practices in waste management and about the circular economy.
- Establish a waste segregation system at source to separate recyclable, hazardous and non-recyclable waste.
- Adopt best practices, technologies, and holistic approach on waste management to maximize recovery of resources and keep them in circulation.
- Explore innovative strategies and solutions to minimize or limit the waste quantity generated across the business operations.
- Collaborate with all the relevant stakeholders to solicit input and promote participation in sustainable waste management.
- Assess lifecycle impacts of waste streams, to ensure responsible handling, storage, treatment, and disposal.


- Implement controls to prevent adverse environmental or community impacts from waste, including proper management of hazardous wastes.
- Establish metrics, waste baselines and set measurable targets for waste reduction, recycling, resource recovery, and diversion from landfill.
- Ensure traceability and responsible management of all waste transporters, recyclers, co-processors, and disposal partners, including documentation and compliance checks.
- Communicate waste performance, risks, and enhancement initiatives transparently through public disclosures and sustainability reporting.
- Take corrective and restorative action in case of waste-related environmental incidents, including remediation of affected areas and prevention of recurrence.

The aforesaid policy shall be made available to all the relevant stakeholders. The policy shall be reviewed periodically, at least every two years, for its appropriateness and updated as necessary.

Oversight & Responsibility:

This policy is overseen by the Managing Director.

Under site leadership, the Operations and Maintenance (O&M) team is responsible for embedding waste management related considerations into relevant systems and processes.
