- Measure, monitor and performance review performances related to the water stewardship of the organization in accordance with this policy to continuously improve our water management practices.
- Assess and manage water-related impacts at the catchment level,

including consideration of shared water users, downstream communities, and local ecosystems.


- Establish water stewardship baselines and set measurable targets for water consumption, efficiency, and recycling performance.

- Engage with key suppliers to promote responsible water practices and assess potential indirect impacts from the value chain.
- Take corrective and restorative actions in the event of water-related impacts caused by operations, including supporting restoration of affected water bodies or ecosystems.
